**Diana L. McRae, Early Voting Clerk**

Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the Walker County Annex, 1301 Sam Houston Avenue, Suite 101, Huntsville, Texas, a public place within the boundary of the District. Diana L. McRae is the Early Voting Clerk and Julie Cooper is the Deputy Early Voting Clerk for said elections and additional Deputy Clerks may be appointed as needed. The Early Voting Clerk's mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots to be voted by mail shall be sent is: **Diana L. McRae, Early Voting Clerk, 1301 Sam Houston Avenue, #114, Huntsville, Texas 77340.** Said Clerk shall keep said place open for early voting by personal appearance for eight (8) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 23, 2017 through Friday, November 3, 2017. Early voting shall also be conducted on Tuesday, October 24, 2017 and Tuesday, October 31, 2017 for expanded hours, said hours being from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on each day at the Walker County Annex which is the Main Early Voting location. Early Voting shall continue through **November 3, 2017 at 5:00 p.m., the 4<sup>th</sup> day** preceding the date of said election. Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on **October 27, 2017.**

Any eligible and qualified person may have his name upon the official ballot as an independent candidate by submitting an application, which, in accordance with Texas Election Code Section 141.031, must be in writing and be signed and sworn to by the candidate and

indicate the date that the candidate swears to the application. The application shall include: the candidate's name; name as it appears on the ballot; the candidate's occupation; the office sought and indication of the term whether full or unexpired; a statement that the candidate is a United States citizen; a statement that the candidate has not been determined totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote as determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction; a statement that the candidate has not been finally convicted of a felony from which the candidate has not been pardoned or had full rights of citizenship restored by other official action; the candidate's date of birth; the candidate's public email address; the candidate's residence address or, if the residence has no address, the address at which the candidate receives mail and a concise description of the location of the candidate's residence; the candidate's length of continuous residence in the state and in the territory from which the office sought is elected as of the date the candidate swears to the application; a statement that the candidate is aware of the nepotism law, Chapter 573, Government Code; and the statement: "*I \_\_\_\_\_, of Walker County, Texas, being a candidate for the office of Board of Managers, swear that I will support and defend the constitution and laws of the United States and of the State of Texas. I am a citizen of the United States eligible to hold such office under the constitution and laws of this state. I have not been finally convicted of a felony for which I have not been pardoned or had my full rights of citizenship restored by other official action. I have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote. I am aware of the nepotism law, Chapter 573, Government Code*" The Applications for a Place on the Ballot shall be signed by such candidates. Such Application must be filed with the Secretary of the Board of Managers at least seventy-eight (78) days prior to the date of said election, same being Monday, **August 21, 2017** at 5:00 p.m. The last day to file a Declaration of Write-in Candidacy is at 5:00 p.m. on **August 25, 2017**.


Only qualified resident voters of said District shall be entitled to vote at said election.

It is hereby determined by this Board of Hospital Managers that voting at said election shall be by the use of paper ballots and the ballots of said election shall conform to the requirements of the Texas Election Code, as amended.

In the event of any vacancies created by death, disability, or refusal to perform by any of the above named persons, the Chairman of the Board of Hospital Managers shall be authorized to appoint such person as he or she deems necessary to fill such vacancy.

This election is authorized to be a *Joint Election* by Joint Election Agreement with Walker County, City of Huntsville, City of New Waverly, City of Riverside, Huntsville Independent School District, New Waverly Independent School District, Walker County Emergency Services District No. 1, and the Walker County Hospital District; using some common polling places and election officers as authorized by Section 271.002 of the Texas Election Code and as provided by a Joint Election Agreement executed by each political subdivision.
